



Post Result Services

Following the publication of results for each examination series, Awarding Bodies offer a range of post-results services:

Clerical re-check - a re-check of clerical procedures leading to the issue of a result. Marks will be added up to check for errors in totalling, but your answers will not be reviewed. A quality check may take place on your script, and this may result on your mark going up or down.

Post-results review of marking - a review of the original marking of your answers to ensure that the agreed mark scheme has been applied correctly

Access to scripts – a copy of the script, either as a priority or non-priority service. A quality check will take place on your script, and this may result on your mark going up or down.

Post-results review of moderation - a review of the original moderation to ensure that the assessment criteria have been fairly, reliably, and consistently applied.

The Awarding Body fee charged for these services will be refunded to you in the following circumstances:

1. If the Review results in a change to an overall subject grade (up or down) when a candidate has cashed-in you will be refunded for any units requested for the subject.
2. If the Review results in a change to the notional unit mark (up or down) you will be refunded for the individual unit only.
