### **Please note:**

- 1 Each subject will provide pupils with detailed information about what is required in their subject.
- 2 Control level refers to the amount of assistance staff can provide and the amount of work that can be completed outside the classroom. Thus, a High control level means that the work is to be completed in class under examination conditions.
- 3 While Science subjects do not have Controlled Assessment they have a PSA (Practical Skills Assessment) which is worth 7.5%. Pupils must complete two practical assessments within one continuous two-hour session and record their results in a booklet which is marked externally by CCEA. The PSA must take place between 1<sup>st</sup> January and 1<sup>st</sup> May in Year 12.
- 4 While Geography does not have Controlled Assessment pupils are still required to carry out fieldwork which will be examined in Unit 3: Fieldwork. This is an external written examination which is worth 20%. Pupils base their answers on their knowledge and experience of fieldwork. Pupils must bring a fieldwork statement and table of data into the examination. The GCSE fieldwork preparation and follow-up will take place in September 2018.
- 5 While there are no Controlled Assessments in Modern Languages, part of the Speaking test is prepared in Controlled Assessment conditions but the full test is taken as a formal assessment.
